C Tier

- Dysphagia
 - RIC Exclusion 01

D Tier

- NT Hemorrhage (Subarachnoid, intracerebral, Subdural)
 - RIC Exclusion: 01, 02, 03
- Cerebral Infarction
 Ric Exclusion: 01
- Note- Hemiplegia not associated to CVA and Flaccid are D tiers but not for stroke patients.

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Activity

74-year-old right-handed male admitted to rehab status cerebral infarction due to thrombosis of left middle cerebral artery. The provider documents patient has right sided hemiplegia, oral dysphagia, aphasia, and right sided and facial droop.

- Diagnosed on EKG but without symptoms: (I25.2)
